When friend's parents and family visit the dojo may will want to record the occasion for personal use. The dojo feels that in most instances this is reasonable.

In all cases the dojo will use a common sense approach and the welfare and safety of all our members will always be uppermost in its decision-making.

However to comply with certain aspects of the data protection act 1998, we would require your permission to take and store images of yourself or your child, for dojo use.

The dojo will only use or permit to be used photographs who the Chief instructor deems or any person duly authorised by him/her to be suitable dressed for the relevant activity.
